 - Based on contemporary intellectual methods NOT Shariah Law

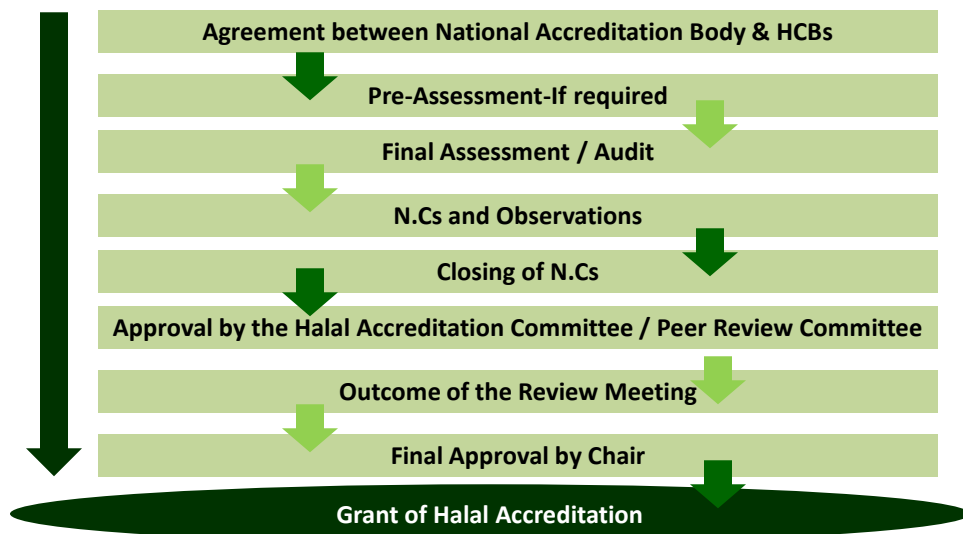
Factors affecting the Sustainability & Acceptability

- Integrity of Certification

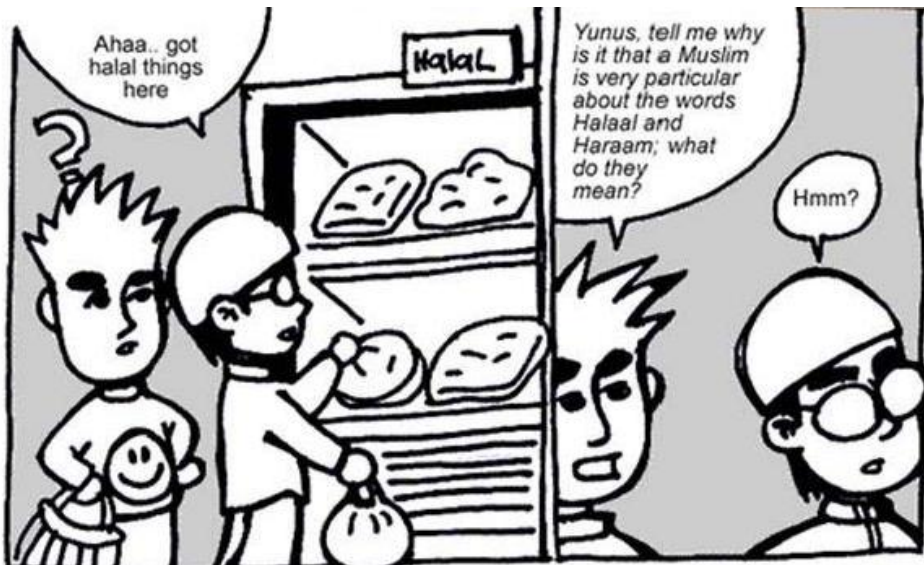
What needs to be done
